

Homeopathy

- In the late 1700s and early 1800s, Samuel Hahneman, M.D., developed the treatment system which we now call homeopathy. His system involved administering small doses of a remedy which in large doses could create the condition being treated. Described as “like cures like” the practice of homeopathy involves first collecting a detailed description of the patient’s exact symptoms: mental, emotional and physical. Based on that list, the homeopath selects the remedy which most closely matches the patient’s symptom picture.

Homeopathy, originally developed in Germany and France, is now widely practiced throughout Europe, India, Russia, and Central and South America. In the United States and Canada, homeopathy has enjoyed a gradual but continuous growth, being practiced by both lay persons and medical professionals.

The homeopathic system of treatment

- Is safe and non toxic.
- Strengthens the body’s defense mechanisms to enhance its innate recuperative capabilities.
- Is routinely used in treatment of children and adults, chronic and acute ailments.
